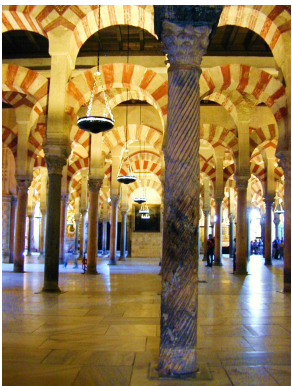
- 8 nights twin accommodation at El Molino

- Cancellation & medical insurance – travel Concepts can assist with this

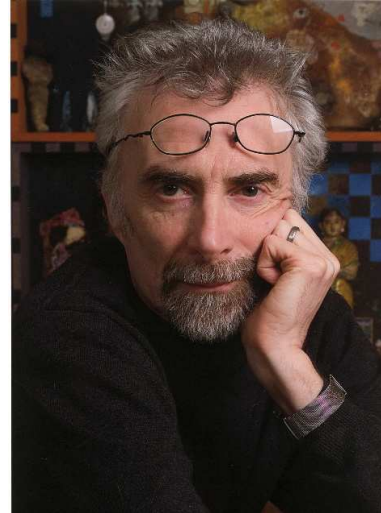
The Details

Set amongst the sweeping olive hills of Southern Spain, midway between Granada and Malaga stands the beautiful restored mill El Molino and it's there, each year, that Mike and Hilary Powell host a series of soirees that offer a chance to relax, eat, drink and learn about the essence of creativity.
